Team with a Vision History

In 1993, two Massachusetts Association for the Blind and Visually Impaired (MABVI) staff ran the Boston Marathon and raised \$4,500. In 1994, Team With A Vision (TWAV) became an official member of the B.A.A. Charity Program. Pam Fernandes assembled a team of 30 visually impaired athletes and guides who raised visibility and funding for MABVI.

Team With A Vision's 1994 team featured Joe Quintanilla, a track star from Cambridge Rindge and Latin School. A 1996 U.S. Paralympic team member, Joe ran for Boston College.

Now celebrating its 30th anniversary, Team With A Vision has raised more than \$4 million for MABVI while showing that with the right support, anything is possible. This year's team features nearly 80 runners from the U.S. and around the globe.

In Memory of Diane Berberian


Dear Friends,

of MABVI's early leaders.




Today, MABVI provides training, therapy, and support to 1,200 people per year in the blind and low vision community, services that allow them to thrive and continue the activities that are important to them.






